

Celebrations and Festivals

Dear Parents,

Welcome to a new term and a new school year. I hope this leaflet will provide a helpful overview of learning for the term.

Our topic for the Autumn term will be 'Celebrations and Festivals'. We will look at different festivals celebrated by different cultures and why they are celebrated. We will learn all about the Harvest Festival, the Jewish Festival of the Tabernacles, Sukkot, followed by the Gunpowder Plot and the activities of Guy Fawkes. We will observe Remembrance Day and then we will learn about the Hindu festival of Diwali, finishing with Christmas.

During PSHE we will look at 'Me and Growing and Changing' and 'Me and My Relationships'. The areas of art, PSHE, design technology and Computing will be taught in a cross-curricular manner.

Mathematics and Literacy will follow the strategy for the foundation stage and will involve a mix of child and adult initiated activities.

In Collective Worship this term we will be looking at 'Friendship' and 'Responsibility'. PE will take place on a Monday afternoon as part of the school enrichment programme. Long hair will need to be tied back and earrings removed at home. PE will happen again later during the week, therefore your child will need their PE kit in school. It is easiest only to take it home at half term and at the end of term to wash. French is taught throughout the school and your child will have regular French sessions. These focus on simple greetings and songs.

At first your child will bring home a book for you to share together. When your child is ready, they will also bring home sound cards and more phonic based books linked to learning in class. I hope you can share these with your child and return the books the next day. Your child will also have a reading record. This is to record reading activities that take place at home. Please sign and comment. Please note that reading at school is recorded separately.

Please ensure that your child has a coat and suitable footwear everyday. For the adventures of 'Fresh Air Friday', we will be outside in all weathers, well nearly all, so Wellington boots will be an advantage. The school provides waterproof trousers.

We will be doing lots of cooking throughout the year. Please inform me if there are any particular food allergies or dietary requirements.

I am looking forward to lots of learning and fun this year and I thank you for your support. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to come and talk to me at the end of the school day.
