#### Communication

We have taken on board feed back about making communication between home and school easier, and have upgraded our Parentmail System. This will enable parents to have all school communication sent via one app. The system will allow you to complete forms for permissions electronically, sign up for clubs and make payments for clubs, school trips and eventually school uniform. All letters and parental emails will also be sent via Parentmail. We hope you find this useful. Miss Jackson will send out emails to all parents that are not yet using Parentmail in due course with signing up instruction. Please do ensure we have an update email for this communication. Parents can register separately for their convenience of access or have one shared contact.

We are pleased to be able to extend our after school offer through use of external providers, which also supports our commitment to staff wellbeing. In a very exciting development, two of our clubs are open for parents and carers to attend as well! To increase accessibility of after schools clubs, we are subsidising full costs to everybody, and children in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM) will be able to attend any after school club free of charge. Mr Ince will be offering Laser Tag again this term, as this was voted our most popular after school club.

### Art Club – Tuesdays 3.15pm – free

We are very pleased that Mrs Ling is able to offer our ever popular art club again this term. This will include some of our Big Art projects and community outreach.

### Reading Café – Tuesdays & Wednesdays 3.15pm – free for children and families

We warmly invite you to come to our after school reading café for a drink and a biscuit, and to share some quiet time with individual reading from our well stocked library. We hope this will be a perfect solution for families who have one sibling in a club or tuition, or for grown ups who would rather not wait outside when it gets cold.

Our after school tuition offer continues to support individual and small groups of children on their learning journey. It is tightly matched to individual learning, and a commitment to attend for the whole programme is expected to ensure maximum impact.

As part of our commitment to healthy and sustainable lifestyles we are delighted to offer a very new club where children can bring their grown-ups with them (parents, carers, grandparents – who ever is collecting that day) to a shared non contact fitness session.
